Item 6. Town Manager Reports:

Chris reported to the Select Board that the outside spicket was broken on Friday. A resident was filling water jugs from the towns well. Chris was able to find a plumber to come and fix the problem. Looking for permission to put locks on the outside spickets. The Town does not have permits for a public well.

Item 7. Old Business:

a. 2024 paving update

Terrie has a motion to only pave just the Reeves Road this year pending the repairs to Station Road. Ed seconded

Discussion on Sept. 5th

Repairing a 200 foot section of Station Rd then paving.

Contractor gave quote of \$11,500.00 to repair road.

220 feet, 20 feet wide, remove pavement, remove 12" of subsurface materials, place 8" of 4"- gravel, compact it, fabric, 4" finish gravel, compact it. Then 2" of shim(binder) and 1 ½" top coat.

Terrie and Ed withdrew their motion and second from Sept. 5th.

Levi motion to pave the Reeves Rd and Station Rd once the repairs to Station Rd are completed.

Carlene seconds VOTE 4-0

b. Middle Rd Bridge update:

The first contractor Earl has not responded to either Chris or Carlene's calls. Chris has contacted Rob Higgins. Rob will look at the bridge and get back to Chris with a quote.

Roadwork: All the berm work is done. Over 50 loads of fill was removed from the sides of the roads. Cemeteries are done. Ditching is scheduled on the Station Road. Scheduled for the 28th. By the beaver dam. Culverts are ¾ up the grates plugged by the beavers.

Down by the old Dewitt place use to be there is a eight foot tall beaver dam. The water is 6 feet above the road. If the dam breaks town will loose the road.

Carlene motions to have Erik remove beaver dam on Station Rd. Ed Seconded

Discussion. Erik will have to remove dam in sections because of the amount of water that behind the dam. While picking the dam apart use the material and build a road for the equipment to use. VOTE 4-0

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Shavings under Swing set (Timber Ridge Lumber)

Ed motion \$2,000.00 to replace old playground equipment and to ask Chris to investigate Middle Road Bridge and Ditching. Carlene Seconded. VOTE 4-0

Cones people just drive over it. Improve driveway entrance. State road and will need to contact DOT about fixing driveway.
