Spring Road Maintenance

- 1. The focus for us in the spring is to improve the roads as much as possible until the roads dry out. We consider this band-aid work to keep the roads as passable as possible.
- 2. We do not want material to be pushed into the ditch ever. Even if there is no ditch, do not push the dirt out where the ditch should be.
- 3. We want birms on the edge of the road to be avoided. Birms prevent water from reaching the ditch.

<u>Summer Road Maintenance</u>

- 1. We do not want material to be pushed into the ditch ever. Even if there is no ditch, do not push the dirt out where the ditch should be.
- 2. We want the potholes to be cut out completely to prevent them from recurring.
- 3. We want the road to have a crown everywhere possible, which is to say, we want a 4% grade on each side so water will shed to the ditch. Please let us know where it isn't possible so we can consider road improvements.
- 4. We want birms on the edge of the road to be avoided. Birms prevent water from reaching the ditch.
- 5. We need to receive invoices that are itemized by date, road, type of work, and charges. For example, "6/12/2023 Pond Rd. spot grading \$300.00"
